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The Margraves of Brandenburg-Ansbach established a modest hunting lodge and summer residence more than 500 years ago in the small village of Triesdorf near Weidenbach. The importance of agriculture for feeding the local population was recognised early on. A dairy was established, and efforts were dedicated to breeding advantageous livestock.

Continuing this tradition, the Middle Franconia district has developed Triesdorf over the past 70 years into a significant educational hub.



Nestled within the listed architectural ensemble of the former summer residence, Triesdorf is now home to ten schools, various experimental facilities, a teaching farm and the local department of the Fachhochschule Weißenstephan-Triesdorf. A true educational cluster has emerged, with an excellent reputation that extends far beyond the borders of Middle Franconia.

More than 3,000 students pursue studies here in agriculture, environmental management, energy and water resources and biodiversity – key fields shaping the future of their professions.

LANDWIRTSCHAFTLICHE LEHRANSTALTEN (LLA)



The Landwirtschaftliche Lehranstalten (LLA) in Triesdorf provide the schools and the university with a comprehensive infrastructure for thorough practical training. They serve as a link between practice, teaching and research, working together to test innovations for their applicability and transferability. In Triesdorf, 330 hectares of arable land – including 112 hectares managed organically in cooperation with the Lichtenau correctional facility – are used for livestock feed production and arable farming. In addition to experimental fields, the educational institutions have access to stables and the technology available at the Fachzentrum für Energie und Landtechnik.

The areas of expertise are divided as follows:

- Fachzentrum für Energie und Landtechnik (Energy and Agricultural Engineering)
- Animal Husbandry with Tierhaltungsschule
- Crop Production and Experimental Research
- Nutrition and Home Economics

The LLA also provides board and lodging for course and seminar participants, as well as for students and pupils. To cover this wide range of activities, around 160 staff members are employed at the Landwirtschaftliche Lehranstalten.



The Landwirtschaftliche Lehranstalten in Triesdorf are an institution of the Middle Franconia district.



Key facts:

- The **cattle barn** houses 130 cows with an annual milk yield of approximately 10,000 kg per cow.
- The **breeding sow herd** of the “Deutsches Edelschwein” (German Edelschwein) breed is maintained and developed through in-house restocking. In addition, gilts (DLxDE) and fattening piglets are also produced and marketed.
- **Sheep husbandry** focuses on herdbook breeding of Merino Landsheep and the production of fattening lambs and breeding rams. It plays a key role in training the majority of German shepherds.
- **Poultry husbandry** maintains pure-bred heritage breeds and breeds them for egg production. The “Triesdorfer Landhuhn” is being developed as a dual-purpose chicken.
- **Beekeeping** supports regional beekeepers by breeding the Carnica bee, supplying queens and offering training.
- A dedicated **energy concept** ensures the Education Centre is comprehensively supplied with renewable energy.
- A **pomoretum** in the Obstlehrgarten is dedicated to preserving heritage fruit varieties. Scionwood is distributed to promote diversity in traditional orchards.
- The **teaching farm** trains up to eight young people annually in various agricultural professions.
- The **Nutrition and Home Economics Department** offers advice and courses under the motto regionality, seasonality and sustainability.

Its pool includes 1,200 apple varieties, 300 pear varieties and 100 varieties of damsons and plums. The varieties are brought together in a historic garden setting, the Pomoretum, which was established as part of a LEADER project.

Under the last Margrave, Christian Friedrich Carl Alexander of Brandenburg-Ansbach-Bayreuth, a dairy was established to process milk from the agricultural operation. Starting in 1785, Lady Elisabeth Craven, who was very close to the Margrave, settled permanently in Ansbach. She brought “recipes for the preparation of all types of cheese” from England to produce higher-quality cheese. Thus, cheese has been demonstrably produced in Triesdorf from Triesdorf milk since 1785. This 240-year tradition is carried on by the Milchwirtschaftlicher Verein Franken e. V. (Franconian Dairy Association) at its teaching dairy in Triesdorf. The Teaching Dairy Triesdorf is the oldest active dairy in southern Germany.

In the Triesdorf Cheese Shop, various cheese specialties and yoghurts produced in our teaching dairy from Triesdorf milk are offered. We are happy to fill your own containers with our delicious products.

In addition, products from other Triesdorf educational institutions, such as honey, spirits, liqueurs, eggs, apple juice, rapeseed oil and lupin coffee, are available. The range is further complemented by a variety of additional regional products.

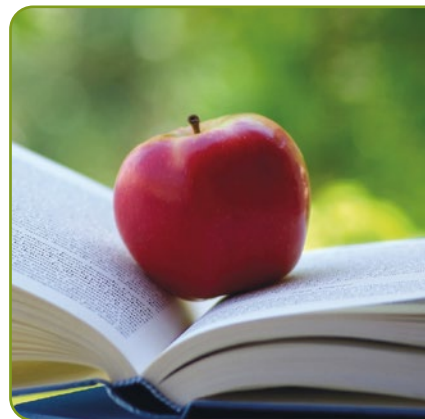

The modern cafeteria is located in the Marstall, a building constructed in 1762/63 by the Margraves, and is operated by the Landwirtschaftliche Lehranstalten.

It offers balanced and delicious meals daily – starting with breakfast, followed by lunch, an afternoon snack and dinner, all freshly prepared.

Lunch guests can choose from up to four different set meals, including at least one vegetarian dish.

A cafeteria run by the Studentenwerk Erlangen-Nürnberg is located in the listed building of the former Gasthaus Adler. This gives Triesdorf's school pupils, university students, staff and all guests at the education centre a dining option in addition to the canteen.

Residential facilities

The Landwirtschaftliche Lehranstalte Triesdorf provide accommodation in its own halls of residence for students as well as all course participants and guests. A modern guest house with 60 beds is also being built directly behind the refectory, due by spring 2026. Social education workers are available in the student residences to help with any concerns. In addition, the management office is staffed at night by a security service. A wide range of educational activities offers students meaningful leisure opportunities.

The favourable location of the market town of Weidenbach, right in the middle of the Franconian Lake District, allows for a variety of water sports, including swimming, sailing and windsurfing. University sports, in collaboration with the municipality of Weidenbach, organise a wide range of activities. Various leisure facilities are available, such as a sports centre, grass and hard courts, tennis courts, a beach volleyball court, a gymnasium, a shooting range and a skating rink. A place with tradition

In 1600, Margrave Georg Friedrich I of Ansbach purchased the Triesdorf manor along with all the local farming estates for hunting and leisure purposes. By the mid-18th century, hunting played a significant role in Triesdorf. Around 1757, however, Margrave Alexander transformed Triesdorf into an agricultural model estate.

To promote general agriculture, a “Landesökonomiedeputation” – a kind of agricultural advisory office – was established in Triesdorf. The estate became famous for the cattle breed “Triesdorfer Tiger”. Sheep were even imported from Spain, and horses bred in Triesdorf were used at the renowned Trakehnen Stud Farm in Prussia. In 1848, the model estate became home to the Königlich Bayerische Kreisackerbauschule Triesdorf (“Royal Bavarian District School of Agriculture”). From this, the modern Education Centre has continuously evolved.
